Elementary cafeteria prices for 2021-2022: **Breakfast: Free, Student Lunch: Free, Adult Lunch: \$3.50 per day.**

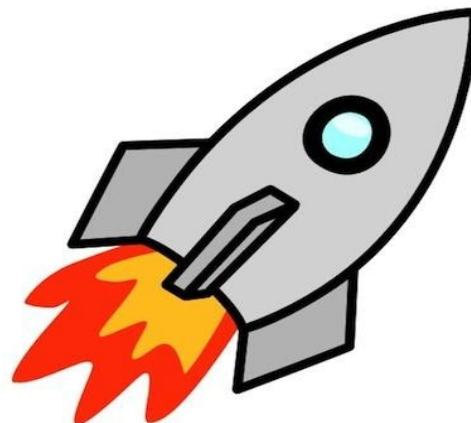
